How can we adapt foreign policy to today's realities?

Poor relations between the major powers leave international institutions such as the UN almost powerless, and humanitarian aid is struggling to keep pace with need, even where it is not obstructed. How did we get here, and what can we do better in the future? And where might the UK best fit in, and contribute effectively?
